Our Puppy Contract & Health Guarantee

Before bringing your new puppy home, we have a puppy contract to be agreed upon and signed. The contract describes the rights and responsibilities of both the breeder and the new owner.

1. There is a \$500.00 non-refundable deposit required to reserve your puppy.
2. The Breeder agrees to release the puppy designated above to the adopter for a _____ adoption fee.
3. The above-described puppy has had been given age appropriate vaccination(s) and first preventative de-worming(s), by our Veterinarian which have been documented in the health record book provided to the adopter. The adopter agrees to provide any/all remaining vaccination and preventive de-worming as appropriate and yearly maintenance for annual health exams and routine vaccinations from a licensed veterinarian
4. The adopter agrees that the above described puppy is being adopted solely as a **pet** for themselves and/or their immediate family. And are in agreement not to sell, giveaway or otherwise dispose of to any persons, breeder, auction or any other entity for any reason without written consent from the breeder. And will contact the breeder if they are unable to provide a healthy and caring environment.
5. The adopter accepts the responsibility of caring for the above described puppy and will provide properly for its welfare in a responsible and humane manner. The adopter agrees to keep the puppy indoors in a clean and pleasant environment, agrees to provide proper nutrition; food and water, daily, veterinarian health care and kind companionship.
6. The adopter is responsible to have the puppy micro-chipped or tattoo to ensure safe return if lost.
7. The adopter will spay/neuter the puppy at personal cost.

What is a health Guarantee?

First of all, the term "health guarantee" isn't quite proper. Nobody can guarantee that anything living won't get sick, whether cats, dogs or even humans. So think of it as a health warrantee.

Our health warrantee consists of two parts:

Part 1 protects you from receiving a sick puppy.

Our veterinarian has completed a health check on your new puppy. You must have your puppy examined by your licensed veterinarian within **five business** days of leaving our care. If your veterinarian determines the puppy is ill; please contact us immediately.

A few important details:

First, we will require an original written statement from your veterinarian.

Second, we will not reimburse veterinarian fees.

Part 2 protects you over the long term for genetic defects and congenital disease.

If your puppy is diagnosed with a life threatening genetic defect or congenital disease before one year of age, the puppy may be returned and a replacement puppy or refund will be provided at the breeder's discretion.

In signing this document, the adopter acknowledges that he/she has read, fully understands, and agrees to all of the terms, conditions and recommendations of the above adoption
